Railroad Yakuza officially launches web presence

TOKYO, Japan | The Railroad Yakuza today announced the official launching of its web presence. "This represents a major step forward for our organization," said one of the Yakuza's five official leaders, who wished to remain anonymous.

The new web site, which had been active on a beta status since late January, had been planned for many months. "Everything just came together," said the official. The site features a new, user friendly layout that allows visitors to learn about the history and purpose of the organization, as well as read about some of its activities.

One of the most exciting features is The Blotter, an occasional comic news source in the vein of The Onion, a leading satirical web-based newspaper. "You might see satirical news stories there, or you may see reports of spoofs and practical jokes undertaken by some of our members," continued the official.

All told, the site will greatly enhance the presence of the organization. Said the official, "we expect that our fingers will be in many pies by the end of the year thanks to this."
